1. Contextual Background:

Global Youth Parliament (in short GYP) is a non-profitable, non-political, social organization not affiliated to any religious sectors. GYP headquarter is in Nepal. Now, we have a country coordinator in 43 countries all around the world. Our work mainly focuses on the theme of Political leadership, entrepreneurship, peace, good governance, democracy and constructive dialogue, inclusive policy formulations, sustainable peace and equitable development. GYP aims to build national, regional as well as global forum for dialogue and advocacy on the theme that needs immediate and longer term global attention like leadership, democracy and good governance, socially responsible trade practices, active citizenship, cultural exchanges and sustainable development and peace. GYP believes that the youth of the world must come together and join hands to achieve the sustainable solutions for greater world community.

On this background, GYP has for the last six years regularly organized programs and activities surrounding these issues mainly focusing on gathering youth opinions and supporting other similar initiatives through our idea innovation workshops. Some of our successful past activities include **Road Referendum(RR)** program aiming to exert moral pressure to the parliamentarians for timely promulgation of constitution, formation of **model youth constituent assembly** featuring 301 youth activists countrywide acting as a youth parliamentarians representing their respective constituencies who engaged voluntarily for over six months in the process of drafting and finalizing the constitution. The model constitution of Federal Democratic Republic of Nepal 2071 was handed over as a reference to the constituent assembly members. Other GYPN activities include youth encouragement for entrepreneurship through which “Tourism Entrepreneurship Award 2013” was organized that awarded 24 young tourism entrepreneurs for their exemplary initiatives. Our milestone event up-to-date was “**Youth SAARC Regional Conference 2017**” organized past April 24-25 in Kathmandu. This South Asian regional conference of youths hosted representatives from more than 13 nations that actively participated in the conference. Several observers and delegates from Kathmandu based diplomatic missions were also present in the conference. The conference has also declared 5-points “Youth SAARC Declaration”. And another milestone event was “**Global Youth Peace Conference 2018**” organized past January 13 and 14 January in Kathmandu. 33 countries were participated and the conference has also declared 7-points “Kathmandu Declaration”. And other two milestone event was “**Asian Youth Assembly 2018**” and “**Global Youth Leadership Summit 2019**”.

In these contextual settings, GYP is currently organizing “**Global youth Leadership Summit 2020**” (Virtual) on 22 and 23 December. The summit will be held in collaboration with Government of Nepal and other Diplomatic Agencies.



2. Objectives:

The overall objective of the **Global youth Leadership summit 2020(Virtual)** is to gather young leaders, innovators, peacemakers, youth activists and civil society pioneers from around the globe in a single forum to share their experiences and knowledge on pertinent global issues. However, the specific objectives of the summit are as follows:

- To encourage the best practices through mutual learning on ideas and initiatives of advocacy tools to achieve sustainable development goals from the youth perspective and motivate youth to lobby them in their own respective governments.
- To share and explore the different ideas of youth leadership, where they play an advisory and productive role in the field of youth policies..
- To inspire and motivate for the involvement of young people in the civil, social, economic and political fiends in their respective country.
- To Reward youth by enhancing and promoting the principle of joint advocacy and action to achieve SDGs through shared responsibility.
- We share and explore the different ideas of peace and democracy.
- To promote the entrepreneurship.
- To motivate for productive role to revitalize global economy after covid-19

- Connection in between youth as well as around the globes by chain of helping.
- Mutual learning based on international best practices of inclusive long-term policy planning and stable regulatory framework
- Explore the nature, purpose, outcomes and learning of youth work through participation and volunteerism from around the globe.
- Intimate discussion with accomplished social innovators of diverse backgrounds with similar goals in the field of social enterprise
- Discover the role and importance of contemporary international relations.
- Establish binding commitments by all the participants to make determined contributions and to pursue measures aimed at achieving SDGs
- Publish a report on the conference and discussion forums.

6. Participants and Resource Persons:

“**Global youth Leadership Summit 2020**” will host approximately 150 countries delegates from across the globes. The attendees will be from diverse background and nationalities and will be balanced in terms of gender. Thematic experts and global academicians will facilitate thematic sessions. Thematic sessions will be moderated by professionals representing different organizations.

“**Global youth Leadership Summit 2020**” will be inaugurated by Honorable Prime Minister of Nepal (K. P. Sharma Oli). The official inauguration of the event will be graced by ministers of Foreign Affairs and Youth from different countries.

7. The Summit:

Summit will have a grand opening and closing sessions and in between four intimate discussion and mutual sharing sessions. Day I will begin with a grand opening session followed by the opening plenary. **Honorable Prime Minister of Nepal (K. P. Sharma Oli)** will officially inaugurate the summit in the role of Chief Guest; other notable guests of the inauguration session include Honorable Ministers of Foreign Affairs and Youth, Resident Ambassadors, Senior Diplomats and UN officials will be invited as the special guests in the opening session. On the opening day one thematic session will followed after the official. Day Two will have two thematic sessions under the overarching theme of “**Next Generation Leaders: The Change Makers of Every Nation**”.



8. Date/sponsors:

The inauguration of the “Global Youth Leadership2020” will be organized on Zoom.
